Entering, moving through and exiting school:

- Each classroom will be assigned an area to line up prior to entering the building. Spaces will be marked on the ground with the appropriate 1-2m distance.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be set up at all entry doors.
- N/K students will have an alternate start/finish time (8:45 am- 11:15am/12:45 pm- 3:15 pm)
- Minimal travel throughout the school will take place. Classrooms will leave their room for Physical Education/Arts, recess and washroom/hand washing breaks.
- All parents will remain outside during entry/exit.

Cohort/Social Distancing

- Social distancing measures will be in effect at all times in the school.
- Classrooms will operate as a cohort. Students will remain with their cohort for the entire day.
- Recess groups will remain the same, with cohorts (classrooms) being assigned areas for safe recess play.

Screening Checks

- Before coming to school, all staff and students are expected to conduct a selfassessment for COVID-19 symptoms using the <u>Manitoba COVID-19 Screening Tool</u>
- Once they arrive at school, a second screening will be conducted to ensure no one exhibiting any symptoms comes into the school.

Increased Cleaning and Disinfecting

- Increased monitoring of hand hygiene and cleaning products to ensure all sinks in washrooms, kitchens and classrooms are well stocked with hand washing supplies at all times (i.e., soap and paper towels, etc.).
- Increased cleaning and disinfecting of objects and high-touch surfaces.

Lunch Program

- A modified version of our Lunch Program will be offered.
- Only students who need to stay for lunch will be permitted. (bus students and students who do not have an option to go home to eat due to parents/caregivers employment/schooling)
- Students will stay in their classroom to eat. Supervision will be provided by our EA's.

Communication

- Staying in touch with our families has always been important. Since parents are only allowed in the school by appointment, our primary communication will be through e-mail and phone calls.
