**PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING COURSE REQUIREMENTS CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORM.**

Total credits required for graduation is 30 in both **academic** and **vocational** programs. 17 credits are compulsory. 13 additional credits must be taken in order to meet the requirements for a provincial high school diploma. At Tec-Voc there are three diploma programs:

**1. Technical Vocational Diploma:** 8 - 10 credits in a Technical or Vocational program **plus** academic requirements.

**2. Academic Diploma:** Standard provincial curriculum.

**3. Dual Diploma:** Tec-Voc students have the unique opportunity to combine a technical program with an academic program. The resulting dual diploma allows students to enter university, community college, apprenticeship training or employment. Please speak to a Tec-Voc counsellor about this program (786-1401).
