Priorities for 2019-20

Students – Maintain creative classroom instruction as well as engaging extra-curricular programs and activities. Student voice in school life as a priority through inquiry-based learning.

Learning Outcomes – Maintain engaging classroom instruction as well as engaging extra-curricular programs and activities. Continue with the Read to Me Framework for literacy instruction from grades 1-6. Explore a similar model for Mathematics instruction.

Addressing Barriers to Learning – Develop and implement school wide expectations focused on building a safe, calm, beautiful environment for learning where everyone feels like they belong. Develop and implement Healthy School plan focused on mental, emotional and physical well-being.

Communications and Partnerships with Community – Maintain current partnerships. Explore student led initiatives to enhance community respect and responsibility.

FOSTER A WELCOMING AND COLLABORATIVE COMMUNITY WITHIN THE SCHOOL AND THE NEIGHBOURHOOD

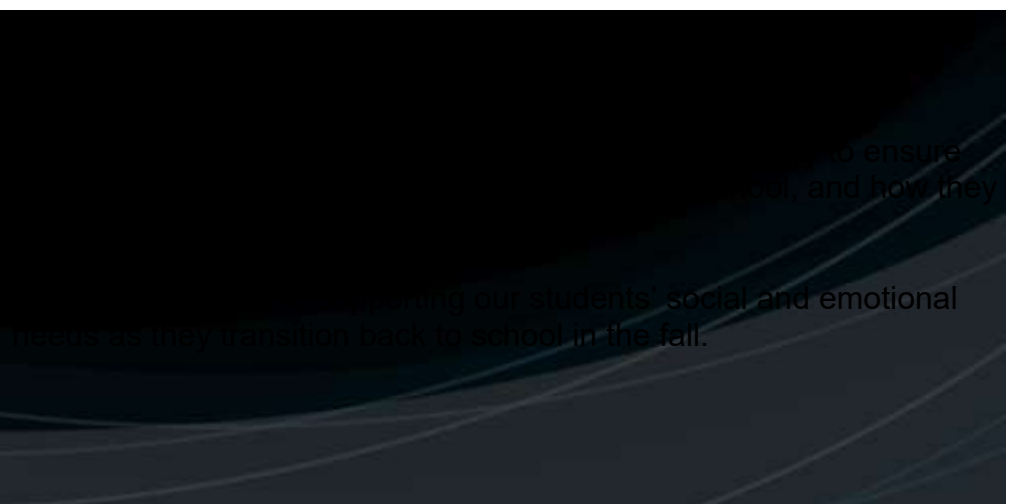
The school will hold purposeful school wide events monthly in order to build school community and to celebrate our learners.
