Welcome to New and Returning Students and Families

After a lengthy closure of schools since March 20, 2020; we are very excited by seeing our students once again starting on September 8, 2020.

This letter, hopefully, will provide you with answers to some of the many questions you may have. The Minister of Health, the Minister of Education and the Winnipeg School Division have outlined guidelines for the opening of schools on September 8, 2020 (Day 4).

These guidelines are in-effect to best protect everyone and keep everyone safe. If you have any concerns or questions, please contact the school at 204-589-4374.

Prior to coming to school:

Ask the following questions:

- 1. Does your child have a fever, chills, cough, sore throat or shortness of breath?
- 2. Has your child travelled outside of Manitoba in the last 14 days excluding travel to western Canada, the territories or Ontario west of Terrace Bay?
- 3. Has your child been in contact with someone that is confirmed to have COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
- 4. Call Health Links at 204-788-8200 for information prior to coming to school.

What to bring:

- School Supplies binders, notebooks, pens, pencils, etc. There will be **NO** sharing of supplies
- Masks are Mandatory where social distancing is not possible
- Water bottle water fountains are closed but refilling stations are open
- Lockers are out-of-bounds so bring only what you need

Arrival at School:

- There are 3 entrances to the building
 - Grade 7/8 South Doors on Powers
 - \circ Grade 9 12 Church Ave. Doors
 - Inclusion Support Students on arrival by bus, students will be guided by Educational Assistants through Salter St./Field House Doors
 - o Arrival at school should occur not earlier than 8:30 am

If a student gets sick:

- ✓ The student will be brought to the office
- ✓ Parents/Guardians will be notified
- ✓ The student is to go home and parents/guardians for more information/support should contact Health Links at 204-788-8200
- ✓ A student may return to school once it has been determined that it is safe to do so by their health care provider
- ✓ If a student tests positive for COVID-19, further direction will be provided by public health
