The ability to communicate effectively in another language provides Immersion graduates with an "extra edge" in an increasingly competitive global economy.

Features of the Program

- Grade 7 Entry Point: There are no second language prerequisites to enter the program. All that is required is a positive attitude and the motivation to learn a second language.
- A Supportive Environment in which students thrive academically and develop the confidence to communicate in a second language.
- Knowledgeable and Committed Staff: Our teachers are caring, experienced professionals, who are dedicated to additional language acquisition and who provide enriched academic content.
- Learning Outcomes: The high level of French proficiency is developed at no cost to students' English proficiency or to achievement in other academic subjects such as science or mathematics.
- Communication: As Immersion is a new experience for students, close communication between home and school is essential and contact between staff, students and parents is ongoing.
- High School: Depending on enrolment, students join the Early Immersion students at Kelvin High School in Grade 10. To achieve full bilingual competencies, students need to continue in the program until graduation. The Late Immersion experience also provides excellent preparation for the International Baccalaureate Program or Advanced Placement Program.
- Post-Secondary Opportunities: By the end of high school, Immersion graduates will have employment opportunities in either English or French or may pursue post-secondary education in either language.
- Other Languages: The Immersion experience gives students the skills and confidence to learn other languages.

- Access to Supplementary Curricular and Extra-Curricular Opportunities: Students in all programs have access to the same course options in other languages, The Arts, Technology, as well as, a variety of extra curricular sports and activities.
- Cultural Enrichment: Immersion students are exposed to a variety of culturally enriching activities — performances, field trips, oratorical competitions, etc.
- ✓ Characteristics of Successful Late Immersion Student:

They:

- have average to above-average achievement at the elementary level
- are verbally-oriented students who like to communicate
- readily accept challenges
- show strengths in their first language
- have good auditory discrimination
- imitate easily and self-correct
- experiment without fear of making mistakes
- are usually attentive and focused
