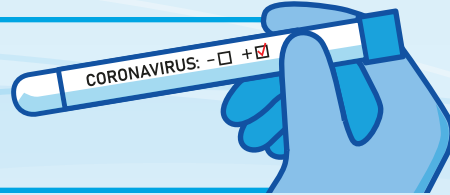
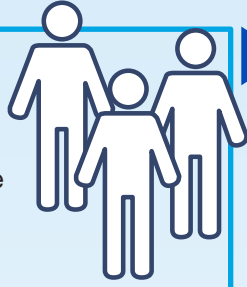


COVID-19 NOTIFICATION PROCESS

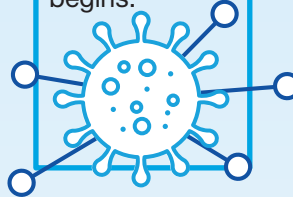
Public health receives a positive lab report for a student or staff person.



Public health officials interview the parent/guardian and child to determine if they were in a school during the infectious period.



Contact tracing begins.



Public health officials notify close contacts (if applicable) and provide any necessary additional steps.

Public health officials inform close contacts when they can return to school.

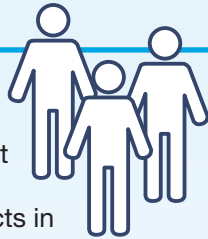


Public health officials notify the principal of the affected school.

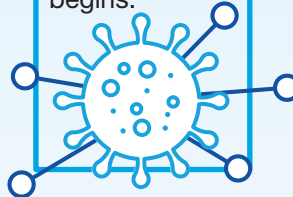


WSD COVID Response Team activated to support school with communications, additional cleaning and fogging, other notifications as required.

Public health officials interview the school principal and/or relevant staff to verify potential exposures/close contacts in the classroom/cohort during the infectious period.



Contact tracing begins.



Public health officials notify close contacts (if applicable) and provide any necessary additional steps.

Public health officials inform close contacts when they can return to school.



Letters are sent from Public Health and the school to inform all parents/guardians in the affected school that a confirmed case was identified.



A public notification is issued.
