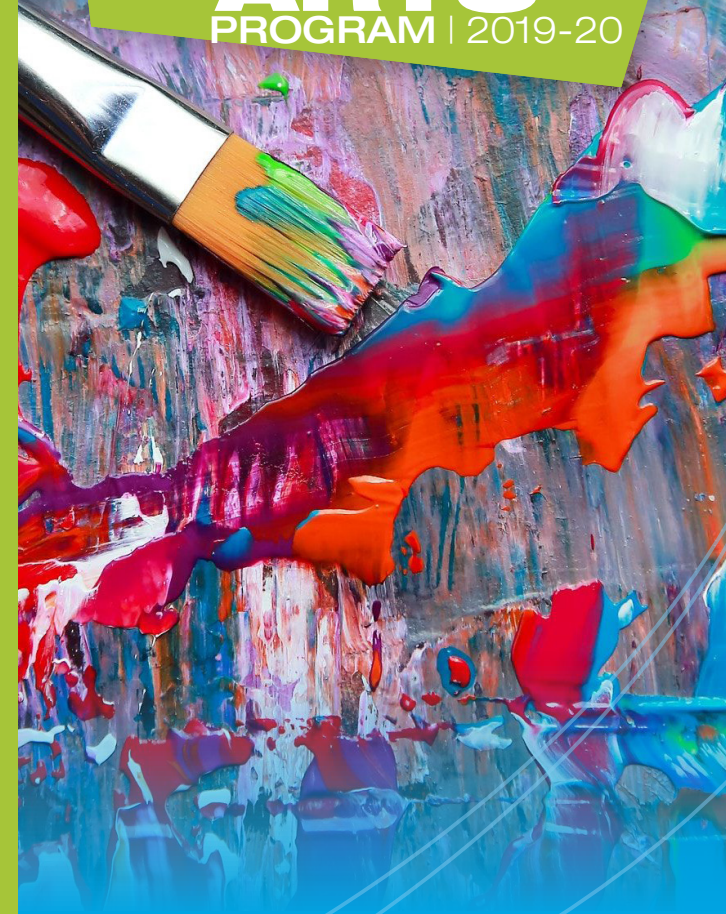

Winnipeg Art Gallery

This is an ambitious and demanding program that requires students to be self-motivated, willing to try new things and able to work both independently and as part of a group.

Students are involved in a large group project as well as a series of smaller individual projects that employ a variety of materials.

The program is structured but open-ended enough to allow for self-expression. Projects are based on themes that allow for a broad scope of artistic possibilities and intend to expand the students' definitions of visual art practice. Themes often involve historical or literary components to add depth and richness to the visual research and exploration.

The program will focus on bridging the gap between high school and post-secondary art programs or professional practice.



Student selection criteria

1. Likes to participate in art activities; eager to express ideas visually.
2. Arrives at creative solutions to problems; willing to experiment.
3. Able to concentrate for long periods of time on art projects.
4. Sensitive to his/her environment; a keen observer.
5. Self-motivated; able to work in a group and independently.



Parking

Quantum students coming to the Winnipeg Art Gallery report to the lobby of 300 Memorial Blvd on the first day. After the first class, students enter WAG Studio from the ramp on Colony Street and wait in the lobby for classes to begin thereafter.
