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Welcome Back!

Hello Sister MacNamara Families,

Welcome back to school! The end of last school year was very challenging due to COVID - 19. We really missed all of you and are looking forward to seeing you soon.

The following information will help you understand the new safety rules at Sister MacNamara School. Much of the school will look the same, but we do have some changes. These changes were created to help keep everyone safe and follow both the Winnipeg School Division and the Provincial recommendations

All staff will be trained on these new protocols prior to school opening for students



Before You Send Your Child to School

- Caregivers must prescreen their child/children to ensure they are not exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms. Any student who is showing any symptoms (including runny nose, sneezing, coughing, etc.) must stay home.

- Pack a water bottle. Water fountains will not be operating at this time.
- Masks are mandatory for students & staff in Grades 4-6. The use of masks for younger students is strongly recommended.

Appointments and Early Pick Up

- Please do not come into the school to pick up your child/children
- There are a couple of options here:
- You can let your child's teacher know that you are coming to pick your child up early and they will send them to the office at that time. You can contact the teacher through their email
- Or, please call (204-942-6965) ahead so that we can have your child ready to go.
- Once you arrive, please call the office and they will be walked out to meet you at their designated door

What Happens If My Child Gets Sick

- If a student becomes ill at school they must go home immediately.
- The student will be brought to the office, given a mask if they don't have one and will be isolated while being monitored by a staff member.
- Parents/Guardians will be called to pick up their child immediately. Children must be picked up as soon as possible.
- Once you arrive, please phone the school and a staff member will walk the child out to meet you.



Increased Cleaning and Disinfecting

- Our custodial staff have been working very hard over the summer to make sure we are ready for a safe return to school. Thank you so much to all our custodial staff.
- There is an increased cleaning schedule for all high touch areas which include, frequent cleaning of doorknobs, faucet handles, electronic devices, washrooms, etc.
- All classrooms have hand sanitizer and cleaning supplies as well
- Hand sanitizer stands will be located at each school entry point

When Arriving at School - 8:50 am & 12:50 pm

Lining Up Outside

All students will meet their teachers in designated, physically distanced spots outside.
 N-3 students will line up on the hardtop, 4-5 students on the field and Gr. 6 students at the back portable doors

Second Screening

 All students will undergo a second health screening before entering the school. It is important that children are healthy and symptom free. Any student who displays any Covid -19 symptoms will have to go home.

Separate Entrances - See Assigned doors below

Exterior doors will be held open for entry and exit by an adult to minimize touch. All inside security school doors will be locked at 9:15 am and 1:10 pm. If you arrive late, please come to the receiving door and call the school and someone will open the doors for your child and proceed with the screening process

Parents in the School

 As much as we wish for an open school community, at this time parent/caregivers are not to be inside the school. If you need to visit the school, please call ahead to make an appointment

Assigned Entry and Exit Doors

Rooms 119, 121, 122, 202 & 206 will enter and exit through the Receiving Door

Rooms 221, 225, 226, 227 & 230 will enter and exit through the Boys and Girls Club Door

Rooms 128 & 129 will enter and exit through the Back Portable Door

If you arrive late, please come to the receiving doors and call the office to be let into the school.



Cohorts, Recess and Lunch Hour Time

Cohorts

 Cohorts are groups of student that will stay in the same part of the school, have recess together and have lunch together if they are in the Lunch Program

Recess

- Cohorts will have recess at the same time
- Recess area options will include designated spaces on the playground, gym, library and classrooms
- Public health advises that playgrounds and play structures are low risk for transmission. There
 are no specific requirement for cleaning play structures at this time

Lunch Time

 If your child goes home for lunch, they will be dismissed out of their assigned door. Your child should not return to school before 12:50 pm

Lunch Program

- Students will eat in their classrooms
- Please send only foods that can be eaten cold, we can not heat food at this time
- Please send your child with their own utensils such as forks and spoons
- Cohort 1 will eat from 12:00 12:30 and go outside from 12:30 12:50
- Cohort 2 will eat from 12:30 12:50 and go outside from 12:00 12:30
- Students will wash their hands before and after eating and being outside

Classroom Set-Up

- All classrooms have been set up to maximize physical distancing.
- All students in grade 4-6 are expected to wear masks.
- Classrooms and materials will be cleaned throughout the day.
- Students will have their own supply kits and materials.
- Soft materials and carpets will not be in classrooms at this time.
- As much as our weather will permit, teachers will be encouraged to hold classes outdoors
- Please ensure your child is always dressed for the weather, including a hat and water bottle

Movement in the School and Washroom Use

Movement in the School

- The amount of student movement during the school day will be limited
- Floors and walls have been marked with directional arrows
- Signage for physical distancing, hand washing and direction is highly visible throughout the school

Washroom Use

- The washrooms will now be separated by cohorts
- Only one student at a time will be allowed in their designated washroom
- The floor will be marked to wait for the washroom when in use
- A system will be in place to monitor the halls and ensure distancing practices are followed
- All washrooms have enhanced cleaning practices in place

Learning for Students

Learning

- All Winnipeg School Division teachers will utilize WSD assessment tools, observations and professional judgement to determine strengths, challenges and next steps in student learning
- Targeted instruction will be crafted to meet the learning needs of your children
- The learning focus will be on literacy, mathematics and student well-being
- We have two full time resource teachers, one special education teacher and an EAL teacher who will support with in-class learning and recovery learning plans
- We will continue to use STEAM and Inquiry based learning to enrich learning and problem solving skills
- All classroom will use either SeeSaw or Google Classroom to support learning and communication with families

This has been a challenging time for everyone, including our children. Making sure that our students feel safe, calm and ready to learn is a priority.

- Our clinicians have partnered with staff to support students in their return to school and will also be available to support families.
- Staff will focus on supporting students who are experiencing all of the emotions and uncertainty this pandemic has created.
- Staff will continue supporting students through Mindfulness, and Self-Regulation initiatives.
- If you require any additional support in dealing with these issues,
 please reach out to your child's teacher or administration.
- We will be very happy to help you.

Dismissal Procedures

- Parents/Caregivers are asked to meet students outside at their designated door or at a meeting place of their choosing
- Nursery, Kindergarten, Grade 1 and Grade 2 students will be closely monitored as they leave the building to ensure safe pick up by daycares or parents
- All pick up points will be at designated doors. Students will not exit through the front doors.
- If a parent/caregiver is late, the classroom teacher will call home for immediate pick up. If you know you will be late for pick up, please call before
 3:30 to let the office know. When you arrive at the school, please call and your child will be escorted out to meet you.
- At this time, we do not know if there will be a Boys and Girls Club Program
