Thank you for your interest in the Flexible Learning and Advanced Programs at Grant Park High School.

Students may apply for the Flexible Learning Program, the Advanced Program, or both, using this application.

The fundamental approach to the **Flexible Learning** classrooms is to encourage students' natural interest by exploring broad themes within the curricula. Students investigate topics and experience them through discussion, hands-on activities, research, cross curricular inquiry, group projects and a wide variety of related explorations. Flexible Learning classrooms utilize multi-age groupings (Grades 7 and 8), and are student-centered, activity-based, and thematically organized. <u>Students are expected to be at or above grade level to allow more depth and investigation into ideas or interests.</u>

The **Advanced Program** challenges students to work at a level beyond the requirements of the curricula set out by Manitoba Education. The Advanced Program provides a rigorous academic environment. The core academic courses are advanced: English Language Arts, math, science and social studies. Critical thinking and analysis are emphasized. <u>High academic standards are required and students are expected to maintain a grade of at least 70% in order to continue onto the next grade level.</u>
