

The four quadrants of a Cartesian plane can now be recognized using ordered pairs, and students have also learned how to conduct and explain transformations of a two-dimensional shape in each of the four quadrants of a Cartesian plane.

In order to answer algorithmic and word problems, students are now studying the addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division of decimal numbers. Students have been given a workbook called "Operations on Decimal Numbers" to use daily at home in addition to class-room work and group projects .
