


Google Meet


Instructions for Families

Your child's classroom teacher will be sending you your child's WSD username and password on Seesaw or via email. This information will be used to log into your child's WSD account to engage in learning with their classmates and teacher on the platform **Google Meets**. We encourage families to support their children when engaging in this digital platform and provide guidance for appropriate online behaviour .



By Tablet, iPad, and Smartphones


1. Download and install the **Google Meet** app from the App Store or Google Play.
2. Open the app and tap on Sign in. Enter your child's **WSD** username. You will then be redirected to the WSD login screen.



3. Enter your child's WSD username and password.
4. Find the link to the Google Meet the teacher has sent. Teachers will use various ways of sharing a link:
 - This might be posted in Seesaw, on Google Classroom, via email or whichever means your child's teacher is using to communicate.
 - Some teachers send this link just a few minutes before the meeting.
 - Nicknames may also be provided by teachers for entering a meeting.
 - You will open the link on the same device that you downloaded the Meet app.
5. Click on the link in the message. You will be directed to the Google Meet app.
6. Tap on the microphone to mute your microphone.


By Computer, Laptop, or Chromebook

1. Open an internet browser like Chrome, Firefox, or Edge. Safari does not support Google Meet.
2. Go to this link <https://goo.gl/S0g7kR> and sign in with your child's username and password.




3. Find the link to the Google Meet the teacher has sent.
 - This might be posted in Seesaw, on Google Classroom, via email or whichever means your child's teacher is using to communicate.
 - Some teachers send this link just a few minutes before the meeting.
 - Nicknames may also be provided by teachers for entering a meeting.
4. Click on the link in the message. You will be directed to the Google Meet.
5. Click on the microphone to mute your microphone.

7. Tap on Join Meeting.



8. After the meeting, ensure that you log out of your child's WSD account on Google Meet.
 - a. Tap on the menu at the top left.
 - b. Tap on the username
 - c. Tap on Manage accounts on this device.
 - d. Tap on Remove from this device.
9. Repeat these steps for each meeting.

6. Click on Join Meeting.



7. After the meeting, ensure that your child's WSD account is logged out.
 - a. Click on the user icon at the top right of the browser window.
 - b. Then click on Sign Out.
8. Repeat these steps for each meeting.
