Administrators' Holiday Greeting



Welcome to December! With the introduction of some colder temperatures and thawing and freezing over the past few weeks, we are reminding students to come dressed for the outdoors. Morning and afternoon recesses are 15 minutes long, while the lunch play time is 30 minutes. All children are expected to be outside unless the windchill is colder than -27 degrees Celsius.

With the arrival of snow, we also face renewed concerns around traffic in the neighbourhood. Our patrols and crossing guards have been told to watch for slower stop times for vehicles, but student drop off can also pose additional problems with snow or slippery sections on the streets. A reminder that we encourage all students to use the crosswalk to cross the street. The safety of our children is always a priority for us, please help to support the safe arrival and dismissal of all students.

We would like to extend our thanks to the ÉSKS Parent Advisory Council (PAC) for their tremendous efforts with the Fundscrip gift card fundraiser that ended last week. Our parent community did an outstanding job of supporting our PAC! Many thanks to everyone involved; there will be information sent out around the distribution of the gift cards in the coming week. We will send out the final tally of money raised for the school.

Our fall reporting period is now over, and our support team (administration and resource teachers) is in the process of meeting with each teacher to discuss the learning in classrooms. These are powerful meetings, where teachers talk about the assessments they have done (and continue to do on an ongoing basis), how they are grouping their children for instruction, and what planning they are doing day to day to meet the individual needs of their students. Teachers talk about trends that they are seeing in classrooms, and how they are working in grade teams to collaborate in their planning for learning. With initial assessments completed, teachers are able to create baseline data in literacy and numeracy that will be used to plan for instruction, and will be tracked through the year to monitor and support student growth.

On the heels of our reporting to you, and the tri-conferences that were held mid-November, we hope that you feel as though you have a good understanding of your child's successes in the classroom, and their next steps for learning. Please know that you are always welcome to contact classroom teachers for further conversation, or to ask questions.

Hot Lunch is continuing in the New Year, with lunches being served to students in Grades 1-8. Thank you to the leadership students and the teachers supporting this popular initiative.

Our volleyball season wrapped up recently with great success experienced on and off the court. We had a dedicated group of teachers who worked hard with students during practices and games. Special thanks go to our coaches and adult supervisors: Mr. Clark, Madame Richer, Ms. Bradshaw, Mr. Smoke, Madame Greenberg, Madame Burokas, Ms. Long, Mr. Ly, Ms. Klanjncar and a group grade 8 students who worked as scorekeepers. We couldn't do it without you! Basketball is next up! Tryouts are underway and many at ÉSKS are eager to get "our game" underway.

Indoor recess

During the winter months, the wind chill is checked before morning recess, lunch time and afternoon recess.

Students are expected to dress appropriately for the weather at all times. As per WSD policy, students will be kept indoors only on inclement days when the wind chill reaches -28° Celsius. When the wind chill is between -25° to -27° , students may go out for a shortened 10 minute recess.

At times, parents and guardians have requested by a note to the classroom teacher or a phone call to the school, to have their child remain indoors at recess time. It is our school's belief that if a students is too sick to go outdoors at recess, then he or she is too sick to be at school.






In partnership with Harvest Manitoba, we are encouraging the whole school to donate non-perishable food items. Help us reach our goal of 1,200 food items!

With the colder weather comes icy conditions. Please be aware of our patrols out on post while you are driving, for your safety and theirs!






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
