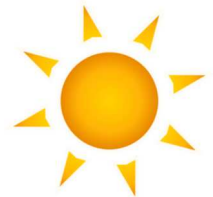
Before we give our final send-off for the 2020-21 school year, we'd love to share with you some of our recent happenings and news as well as important information for next year:

LUNCH PROGRAM

All of us at the Lunch Program wish you a wonderful and safe summer holidays!

We are delaying registration to the end of August to ensure we can bring you the most efficient and straightforward process for registering your family for childcare over the lunch hour.

LUNCH PROGRAM IS FOR ALL FAMILIES WITH GRADE ONE—SIX STUDENTS:
If your child remains at school over the lunch hour, you must enroll in this program

About Lunch Program...The Brock Corydon Lunch Program is a very affordable childcare service provided by the Parent Advisory Council. It is a non-profit program that provides supervision for children remaining at school over the lunch hour – if your child remains at school you must enroll in this program. Lunch Program is supervised by the Lunch Program Coordinator and operated by paid staff. All Grade 1-6 students are eligible for the program which runs daily in the classrooms.

New this Fall... In April, the PAC voted an increase in lunch program fees. This increase was necessary to ensure that we can afford to continue to operate. Currently we are anticipating bringing back hot kettles and some microwave use. Over the summer, we will be updating and finalizing lunch procedures and protocols for the fall. The 2021-2022 Brock Corydon Lunch Program Registration Package will be distributed by email at the beginning of September. It will outline Lunch Program guidelines, what we offer students over the lunch hour, and registration and payment information.

Registration is for all students... if your child remains at school you must enroll in this program, regardless of part-time or full-time attendance.

We are working to streamline our paperless registration process to serve you better. We will be very firm about receiving forms and payment in a timely manner so be sure to return your registration by September 15. To apply for the Lunch Program in the 2021-2022 School Year, your account must be in good standing.

Monitor positions for the 2021-2022 School Year

This is a great opportunity to off-set your lunch program fees and be involved in your local community while earning extra money.

Positions are Monday to Friday on full-school days only
