Art/Drama

Art is integrated with many other subjects and involves a variety of projects using different materials and techniques. Students will have opportunities to express themselves creatively through drama.

Mathematics

Students will develop their math skills through problem solving, group math activities, class lessons, and Number Talks. Students will progress from hands on activities to visual representation. Students will demonstrate their understanding by using mathematical language, modelling, math symbols and numbers.

- They will develop skills such as:
 - Numbers up to 100, counting, adding, and subtracting
 - Increasing/repeating patterns with numbers to 100
 - Describe equality and inequality
 - Number of 10's and 1's in two-digit numbers
 - Skip count by 2's, 5's, and 10's to 100 forward and backward
 - Relating addition to subtraction to solve problems
 - Represent, compare, and order numbers to 100
 - Awareness of 2D shapes and 3D objects
 - Measurement, estimation, and time
 - Use different math strategies to solve addition and subtraction facts to 20
