

Wind Chill	Risk of Frostbite	Other Health Concerns	What to Do
Note: The guidelines on Frostbite in the table apply to healthy adults			
0 to -9	Low	*Slight increases in discomfort	*Dress warmly; with the outside temperature in mind. *Stay dry.
-10 to -27	Low	*Uncomfortable *Risk of hypothermia if outside for long periods without adequate protection.	*Dress in layers of warm clothing, with an outer layer that is wind resistant. *Wear a hat, mittens or insulated gloves, a scarf, neck tube or face mask and insulated, water proof footwear. *Stay dry. Keep active.
28 to -39	RISK: exposed skin can freeze in 10 to 30 minutes	*Risk of frostbite: Check face and extremities (fingers, toes, ears & nose) for numbness or whiteness. *Risk of hypothermia if outside for long periods without adequate clothing or shelter from wind and cold.	*Dress in layers of warm clothing, with an outer layer that is wind resistant. * Cover exposed skin. *Wear a hat, mittens or insulated gloves, insulated, water-proof footwear. *Stay dry. Keep active
-40 to -47	HIGH RISK: exposed skin can freeze in 5 to 10 minutes	*High risk of frostbite: Check face and extremities (fingers, toes, ears & nose) for numbness or whiteness. *Risk of hypothermia if outside for long periods without adequate clothing or shelter from wind and cold.	*Dress in layers of warm clothing, with an outer layer that is wind resistant. * Cover all exposed skin. *Wear a hat, mittens or insulated gloves, a scarf, neck tube or face mask and insulated, waterproof footwear. *Stay dry. Keep active
