-40 to -47	HIGH RISK: exposed skin can freeze in 5 to 10 minutes	*High risk of frostbite: Check face and extremities (fingers, toes, ears & nose) for numbness or whiteness. *Risk of hypothermia if outside for long periods without adequate clothing or shelter from wind and cold.	*Dress in layers of warm clothing, with an outer layer that is wind resistant. *Cover all exposed skin. *Wear a hat, mittens or insulated gloves, a scarf, neck tube or face mask and insulated, waterproof footwear.
