# **SAFE ARRIVAL**

To enhance our existing absence-checking procedure, Tec-Voc is using a student absence reporting system called Safe Arrival. Safe Arrival will make it easy for you to report your child's absence. Parents/Guardians are asked to report their child(rens) absence in advance using any of these 3 methods:

- Using your cell phone, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple Store or the Google Play Store (or from the links at https:// go.schoolmessenger.ca). The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
- Use the SafeArrival website, https://go.schoolmessenger.ca. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account. Select **Attendance** then **Report an Absence**.
- Call the toll-free number **1-855-278-4513** to report an absence using the automated phone system.

These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week. Future absences can be reported at any time. Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we implement this new system.
