SENIOR HIGH PROGRAM

Students have the unique opportunity to earn both an <u>Academic</u> and a <u>Technical Vocational Diploma</u> while learning at Tec-Voc High School. We offer a variety of Academic and Technical Vocational programs that may lead to further study at University, Community College, Apprenticeship or employment.

Students must complete 30 credits in order to graduate high school. Students who register in an Academic program may choose from a full range of courses including those required for university entrance. In order to graduate with a Technical diploma, students must obtain 8 credits in a specific program.
