- Principal Appointment: M. Sacco Ms. Sacco moving to River Elm on Feb 1 as Acting Principal. No replacement announced yet.
- Sleep in Heavenly Peace Bed Project Update Mr. Puntin and several students building 150 beds for families in need. Students are very involved and engaged in helping the community. A former SRO officer brought the idea to Tec Voc.
- Food Rescue hamper program over the summer was a success. Restaurant suppliers have overstock of food, etc. due to the pandemic. Tec Voc and RB Russell may become a permanent drop-off point for excess food to be delivered to families in the community. Students to learn supply chain management skills. Students will also be able to take their certified forklift operator's license (must be 18 yrs old).
- SRO Survey –SRO program. WSD1 surveying parents, students, school staff and SROs re: SRO program.
- Remote Learning Attendance province is requesting data from school divisions on remote learning attendance. Students not checking in with teachers through various methods will be marked absent.
- Report Cards report cards go out on February 18 & 19. There will be extra comments regarding engagement and remote learning, and how students are doing with it. Report cards will be sent online.
- Semester 2 start date February 9, pushed back one week by province. No final exams for Semester 1.

- Covid Update parents get information at the same time as staff regarding school closures, etc. Parent discussion regarding their children's' experiences with schooling from home. Province and schools developing 'recovery models' for students who have missed out because of home learning.
