## About our school

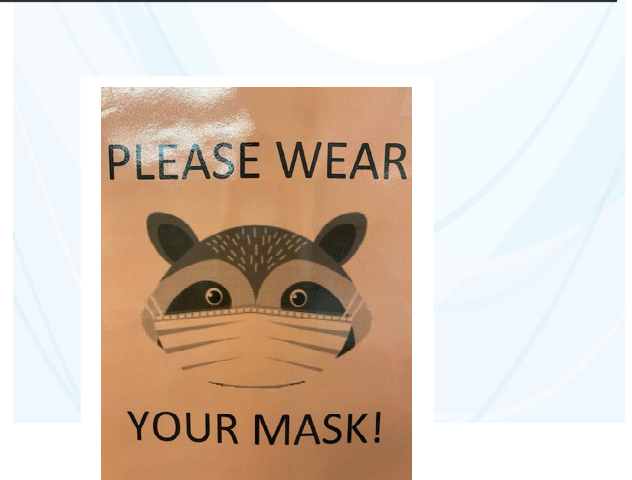
- Dual track elementary school
