

COLD WEATHER

Just a friendly reminder about the cold weather and the guidelines.

Staff will be available to greet students for entrance after 8:45am during cold weather days. At lunch time, doors will be open for student entrance at 12:55 pm.

There will be no entry prior to those times! Please do not send your child to school prior to these times as they will not be allowed into the building.

Lunch program students will be supervised in the classroom by the Lunch Program staff. They are not available to supervise students not registered for Lunch Program.

Cold weather guidelines are as follows: <u>INDOOR RECESS</u>: Students stay indoors for recess when the wind chill reaches –28 degrees Celsius.

Please ensure your child dresses appropriately for the weather, wearing a winter parka, mittens, hats, scarves, ski pants and winter boots.

TRIAD MEETINGS

Parent Teacher meetings are scheduled for Thursday, December 3rd, 2021 from 1pm-6pm. Nursery/Kindergarten interviews will be a full day. On Thursday, November 25th, an email was sent to parents/guardians via School Messenger to sign up for an appointment with your child/ren's classroom teacher(s) for Parent Teacher Conferences. These will be virtual interviews and once you sign up, you will receive a link you will use at your assigned time to meet with the classroom teacher. If you are unable to attend your scheduled meeting time, please contact the classroom teacher to set an alternative time.

If your child requires an Individualized Learning Plan, the classroom teacher will review this with you during the meeting and you will be able to ask any questions you have at that time.

INTERPROVINCIAL TRAVEL

Fully Vaccinated Travellers

Asymptomatic, fully vaccinated persons aged 12 and older do not need to quarantine upon arrival in Manitoba and can attend school.

Children under 12 travelling with fully vaccinated persons

Children under 12 are not required to quarantine and can attend school if they are asymptomatic and all eligible persons they are traveling with are fully vaccinated.

Children under 12 travelling with persons who are not fully vaccinated

If children under 12 are travelling with someone who is eligible but not fully vaccinated, they must quarantine for 14 days upon arrival back in the province.

Unvaccinated Travellers

Unvaccinated persons aged 12 and older must quarantine for 14 days upon arrival in Manitoba.

INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL (INCLUDING THE UNITED STATES)

Fully Vaccinated Travellers

Asymptomatic, fully vaccinated persons aged 12 and older do not need to quarantine upon arrival in Canada and can attend school.

Children under 12 travelling with fully vaccinated persons

Unvaccinated children under 12 years travelling with fully vaccinated persons do not need to quarantine, but must follow enhanced public health measures, including not attending school or daycare for 14 days upon arrival in Canada.

Children under 12 travelling with persons who are not fully vaccinated

If children under 12 are travelling with someone who is eligible but not fully vaccinated, they must quarantine for 14 days upon arrival in Canada.

Unvaccinated Travellers

Unvaccinated persons aged 12 and older must quarantine for 14 days upon arrival in Canada.


