# Student Medications

## Medications for Students

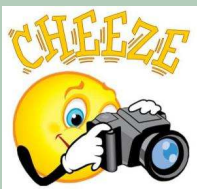
Every year, the school gets a number of requests for medication to be administered to students. In order to be able to accommodate these requests, the following must be in place:

- Medication must be prescribed by a physician and come in a container with the pharmacy label.
- **We are not able to administer over the counter medication unless it is prescribed and labelled.**
- Parents must fill out an Authorization form.
- The medication must come in the proper dose and or have a proper measuring device.
- The student must have been administered the first dose at home.
- **Unless the above conditions are met, medications presented to the school are not able to be administered.**

## EPIPENS AND INHALERS

If your child has been prescribed an EpiPen or inhaler, please ensure that your child has the medication with them and that the school has been notified. In order to respond to your child's health care needs, information is collected, shared with school staff, and a health care plan is put into place with the Public Health Nurse. Please contact the school if you have any questions.
