Please remember that children should arrive at school no earlier than 8:45 am as there is no supervision prior to this time. Patrols will begin crossing children safely at 8:40 am and 3:25 pm, students are dismissed and should be picked up promptly or walk directly home.

As a reminder, there are two parking restrictions in effect on Redwood Avenue from McPhillips to the backlane. McPhillips to the first no stopping sign (this is the area along the fenced car lot); there is NO parking or stopping in this area at any time. McPhillips to the backlane; there is NO parking or stopping in this area from 3:00-4:00 p.m. daily. Instead, please pick your child up at the opening in the fence at the "STOP, DROP and GO" sign on Aberdeen Avenue, where it is safe for them to enter/exit on the curb side. Thank you for your continued cooperation in working to keep our children safe on the icy streets!

It is very important that your children are dressed appropriately for the weather. January is a very cold month! Students will continue to go outside for two 15 minute and lunch recess periods in order to continue to stimulate their brains with fresh air and their bodies with physical activity. If the temperature and wind chill are below -27°C , the students will stay inside.
