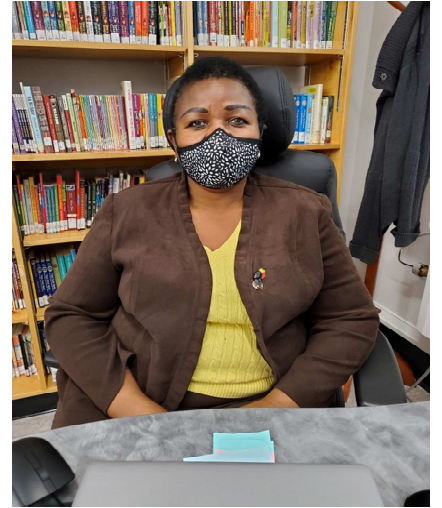


Please help me in welcoming Ms. Justine Kiwanuka, the new Community Support Worker of Mulvey School effective, Tuesday, November 2, 2020.
