Report Cards and Student-led Conferences

A link to your child's report card will be emailed on **Tuesday, March 16**. The link will enable you to access .pdf version of the report card. A signed, paper copy of the report card will be printed out and placed on file.

On Thursday and Friday, RHS will host virtual student-led conferences. Michael Absolum describes student-led conferences the following way:

Not only is the student the best person to tell his or her parents what he or she has learned, but if we believe that students build their knowledge by communicating what

they know, then providing an opportunity for the students to tell their family what they know can significantly assist with that learning ...

What do we mean by a student-led conference? We mean a conversation between the student, parents, and teacher that is focused on recent learning. The meeting setup is managed by the school and teacher, but the conversation is led by the student.

All participants in well-planned and organized student-led conferences have found them to be powerful experiences for students, parents, and teachers. The responsibility undertaken by the students to share and evidence their learning with their parents/caregivers, to show them what they have learned, becomes a key factor in enabling rich communication between all parties and strong motivation for learning. (Clarity in the Classroom: Using Formative Assessment for Building Learning-Focused Relationships, page 205)

During the student-led conferences next week, students will reflect on their strengths, identify areas to strengthen, and talk about goals they have set.

Here are some tips for conference success:

- ✓ Please log on at your appointment time with your child using the link provided in School Appointments.
- ✓ Your child can be on the same device.
- ✓ Multiple devices / logins can be accommodated if desired.
- ✓ If the teacher has sent something home to follow, ensure that your child has it ready.
- ✓ Review the report card in advance of parent conferences and note questions.
- ✓ If you need to set up an additional time to talk one-on-one with the teacher, please set up a separate time to do so.
