Calendar of School Closure Dates

Each year, schools set aside ten non-instructional days to conduct administrative work and teacher professional development. Some of the dates are designated provincially, some by the metro school divisions, and two by the school itself. Here are the closure dates for the 2020 – 2021 school year:

- September 2 4, 2020 (preparing schools for reopening)
- October 23, 2020 (school choice)
- November 20, 2020 (tri-conferences)
- February 8, 2021
- March 19, 2021 (student-led conferences)
- May 3, 2021
- June 7, 2021 (school choice)
