

## Message from the Administration

We have had a full week at RHS! At the time of this writing (Saturday afternoon), we have staff members and additional custodians in the building moving classrooms and setting up learning spaces for Monday morning.

To briefly summarize the changes that we have made, we looked again at all available spaces within the school to ensure physical distancing of two meters. We have tried, as much as possible, to restore children to their original classrooms/teachers. We have also restored our performing arts and physical education programming. We will use our educational assistants in some classrooms in a very intentional way, supporting learning with teacher planning. We will monitor how students are entering and exiting the building with our new classroom assignments and may need to adjust to minimize congestion. We will update you should this become necessary.

We heard from many parents since we sent the email outlining upcoming changes to classrooms and programming. We appreciate the kind words of support and were able to share these sentiments with staff members. We were humbled by your responses and kindness.

### Parents Advisory Group (PAG) Update

## Masks – Updates

With the provincial move to a "Red Status" in Winnipeg, we have considered further changes that may be required at school. Until now, we have allowed our students in grades 4-6 to be without masks at recess time. We learned on Friday that the province has now mandated that students in grades 4-12 are required to wear masks during Physical Education periods, even when outdoors.

We have decided to require mask-wearing at recess time for students in grades 4-6. Teachers will endeavour to find times for students to have some mask-free time (other than during the eating of snacks and lunch). Wear masks outside reduces the possibility of mask-less chatting while in line. Students also sometimes have trouble distancing from one another while moving in or out of the school, so requiring masks seems a prudent move at this time.

By way of reminder, students are to wear face masks and not "neck gaiters" - the buff-style "neck tube" that can be pulled up and down over the mouth and nose. Some students are continuing to wear them around the neck and forgetting to pull them up, or they are regularly sliding down.

We continue to strongly recommend the wearing of masks with children younger than grade four if possible. While our children have done a wonderful job of adjusting to our new routines, there continues to be the possibility of children forgetting to distance, running into another child or speaking next to somebody in line without a mask. Any enhanced measures through this time are encouraged.

### Photo Retakes

Photo Retakes will take place on **Monday, November 9, 2020** in the morning. If your child missed the first photo session or requires a retake. Parents with a student in the afternoon Nursery and Kindergarten program can bring their child at 8:45 am on retake day to have their photo taken. We ask that parents call the school office at (204) 488-1137 when they arrive outside, and someone will come gather your child to bring them in for their retake photo while you wait to take them home. LifeTouch has implemented new procedures to ensure picture day is safe. Individual pictures will still be taken.

## Remembrance Day

We have a virtual Remembrance Day Assembly planned for the morning of November 10<sup>th</sup>. Classrooms will be continuing the tradition of creating wreaths, and this year, two representatives will bring them out to the flagpole to be placed outside for the day (weather permitting).

Our grade six students will be involved in the assembly and a guest speaker is going to meet with us virtually. We thank Lieutenant-Colonel Joseph Doubrough, CAOC Mission Support Division Chief of 1 Canadian Air Division Headquarters (and dad to Ivy in grade one) for accepting our request to address our students.

We hope to be able to offer an opportunity for our parents to join us virtually. We have needed to put a "pause" on our planning these past two weeks with everything going on at school, but you will learn more in the coming week.

Each year, RHS has held a Scholastic book fair. To continue the tradition, Scholastic has come up with a way to hold virtual Book Fairs. The book fair will be open for shopping between November 16 and 30. A portion of the sales from this book fair enable RHS to purchase new materials for the library. Stay tuned for details.
