Movies are available to stream at home or at school. Students can access them as can teachers. Or go old school and order a DVD to screen!

Choose from:

- DVDs from Library Support Services, sent out to your school or pick up directly.
- Can-CORE (new!) (stream).
- **Criterion-on-Demand** (stream).
- Discovery Education (stream).
- National Film Board (stream).
- WSD Digital Library storybook videos (stream).

CAN-Core is a collection of Canadian films in French and English, on a wide range of subject areas for all grades. Films can be viewed at home or school. Excellent Health and Family Life, Indigenous content, Social Studies, Environmental issues, Vocational courses, and more.

Search by title, by curriculum area, by course name. Movies are correlated to the MB Curriculum. Find movies by title or subject. Or use **Curriculum Search**. Choose your subject area, in **Course/Section** choose the course you're teaching, filter by **Audience Level** to find the best choices for your students.

Criterion offers full length movies – there are many informative and fun movies to view. Search for movies by title or browse genre collections.

This year, students have their own special login so they can watch a smaller selection of movies at home. As staff, you have a larger number of titles to view. If you are showing movies at school, you can choose to play any title from the larger selection.

DE can be accessed at home or at school, by students and teachers. It has information videos in many subject areas, as well as editable videos, images, virtual field trips and instructional strategies. You can filter what you find by grade level.

Look up videos by subject, keyword or channel.

*Students in grades K to 3: Username = network user name; Password = 123qwe (*student accounts must be enabled at school first)

Stream short Weston Woods picture book-based movies online from the **WSD Digital Library: Classic Version.** You'll find titles like **Brave Irene** by William Steig, funny fairy tales by **James Marshall**, holiday stories and much more.

When you go to the URL, choose the Classic site, not SORA.

Find the videos by going to *Advanced Search*, select *All Formats*, choose *Streaming Video* from the dropdown menu. Click *Search*.
